How is SCA run?

SCA is a social enterprise company, limited by guarantee which means that after our overheads have been paid for, any residual monies go back into furthering the aims of SCA, which are:

- To promote the work of artists living and working in and around Southport
- To encourage our wider community to engage with creative activity.

There are no paid members of staff within SCA, everyone works with us on a voluntary basis, however if you run a workshop for us there can be a payment to you as a self employed artist.

We run in a co-operative manner, in which we hope that all of our members will give a little time and effort into the activities of the network.

We endeavour to have quarterly network meetings at which we discuss activities coming up and new ideas. Please try to attend these meetings, as your input is important to us all.

ArtHouse

In April 2012 we opened ArtHouse, which gave us the opportunity to showcase work, run classes and offer studio space. ArtHouse also serves as a headquarters for the network and we hope that you will take the opportunity to pop in to meet other members and involve yourself in the creative community that it offers.

SCA Membership has 3 categories: Friend / Full / Exhibiting

As a Full Member of SCA we ask that you give at least 2 x 2.5hrs per month to help staff the Gallery.

ClayWorks

We opened our ceramic studio in February 2016. We run weekly and one off classes in ceramics.

ArtsLoft

We opened our ArtsLoft studio space in May 2017, and now run all of our weekly and one day special classes from there. If you are interested in running any workshops from ArtsLoft, as either weekly classes or one off half day or full day sessions in your specialism, please speak to Norrie for more details.

Community Interaction

We try to run several activities that enable the community to engage in a fun and accessible way, with creative activity. For Example:

- Pop up exhibitions
- Workshops with National Trust
- Extreme knitting fundraising knitting Christmas tree festival
